Aggreko was founded in The Netherlands by Luc Koopmans in 1962. It moved to Scotland in 1973. In 1984, it was acquired by Christian Salvesen plc in 1984, a Scottish transport and logistics company. In 1997, the business demerged from Christian Salvesen and then listed on the London Stock Exchange.

Aggreko is the world's largest temporary power company. It has more than 10 gigawatts of power across its fleet globally. The company employs over 6,000 people and operates across the world in more than 200 locations in 80 countries and has offices in every continent.
