

Fort Barrington (previously Goat Hill Fort, Cripplegate Battery, and Queen's Battery) is a historic military fort in Antigua and Barbuda. It is located on Goat Hill in St. John's, Antigua, at the western entrance to St. John's Harbor. The fort was built in 1779, and was named for Admiral Samuel Barrington. Remains of the fort include a circular battery, small magazine, and barracks.

The Green Barbuda project is a hybrid solar, batteries and back-up diesel project, featuring a hybrid PV plant with 720 kWp of solar panels connected to a 863 kWh battery. It is capable of fully meeting the island's current daytime energy demand.

In 1745, a new battery was built across from Fort Berkeley, to guard the eastern entrance to English Harbour. [1] Originally, the fort was called South East Point Battery, and consisted of two gun platforms, a guard house, a kitchen, and latrines. [1] It was armed with 11 cannons. [1]

Construction of the modern Naval Dockyard in English Harbour began in the 1740s. During that time, Fort Berkeley was significantly expanded and upgraded, as it guarded the western entrance to English Harbour. In 1745, a new battery was built across from Fort Berkeley, to guard the eastern entrance to English Harbour. Originally, the fort was called South East Point Battery, and consisted of two gun platforms
