

# Approval process for photovoltaic panels for farm houses

Do solar farms need planning permission?

Ground mounted solar panel systems of greater than 9m sq. (4-5 large solar panels) require planning permission. This means that all solar farms require planning permission. In order to get approval for solar farms in the UK, a series of rigorous planning procedures must be passed before work can begin.

Can solar farm planning permission be halted in the UK?

Do I need planning permission to install a solar PV system?

This amendment classifies the installation of a residential solar PV or solar thermal system as 'permitted development' meaning planning permission is not required before work commences assuming that the installation fulfills the following conditions:

Where should a solar farm be built?

Solar farms are normally built on rural land. There needs to be careful thought given as to the suitability of the land chosen for a solar farm. The prime spots for solar farms are either on flat land or on a south facing slope. Ground mounted solar panel systems of greater than 9m sq. (4-5 large solar panels) require planning permission.

Can a solar farm be built by 2035?

It aims to achieve 70 gigawatt (GW) of solar power by 2035 (up from 15.8 GW as of March 2024). Solar farms usually require planning permission. The size of a solar farm will determine which body decides the application. For example, in England:

Do I need planning permission to install solar panels on my roof?

If you plan to install four or five solar panels on your roof, it's unlikely that you'll need to apply for planning permission as the project is incredibly small. However, panels up to 50kW on rooftops don't need planning permission (as they're considered permitted development).
