

What percentage of Spain's electricity is renewable?

By 2019, wind and solar energy made up 21% and 6% of total electricity generation, respectively. The installation of photovoltaic (PV) plants beginning in 2007 played a key role in this increase, doubling the renewables' share in Spain's electricity mix from 20% in 2008 to 40% in 2013.

Will Spain raise its share of renewables by 2030?

According to a draft government report issued in June, Spain's goal is to raise the share of renewables to four-fifths by 2030. The new climate plan includes higher targets for solar and wind power capacity as well as energy storage.

How did renewables affect Spain's electricity mix?

The installation of photovoltaic (PV) plants beginning in 2007 played a key role in this increase, doubling the renewables' share in Spain's electricity mix from 20% in 2008 to 40% in 2013. After this period of growth, the share of renewables in Spain's electricity generation leveled off, reaching 37% by 2019.

Can renewables solve Spain's nuclear crisis?

What will provide more flexibility is hydropower and, within hydropower, pumping," adds the expert. " By 2030, Spain will have three fewer nuclear reactors and it turns out that renewables are solving the problem on their own," says Pedro Fresco, former director of Energy Transition in the Valencia region.

What is the power capacity of Spain's renewable generation fleet?

The power capacity of Spain's renewable generation fleet reached 64,182 MW at year-end and 46.7% of total generation in 2021 was produced with renewable technologies, both values represent all-time highs. (1) Includes biogas, biomass, geothermal, marine-hydro, wind-hydro and renewable waste.

Where is the most renewable power in Spain?

From the point of view of the autonomous communities (regions in Spain), most of the installed renewable power capacity is located in four regions, Castilla y Le#243;n, Andalusia, Galicia and Castilla-La Mancha, which together account for almost 56.7 of the total installed renewable power capacity nationwide.
