The delivery comes as part of the final phase of the Emergency Recovery Project (ERP1). The NRPB is implementing the project on behalf of the Government of Sint Maarten, which is funded by the Sint Maarten Trust Fund and financed by the Government of the Netherlands, managed by the World Bank.

To respond to the emergency and recovery needs of Sint Maarten, the Government of the Netherlands established a Single Donor Trust Fund (SDTF) of EUR 470 million managed by the World Bank to support the rapid and sustainable recovery of Sint Maarten. In response, a crisis team meeting was urgently convened with representatives from the Netherlands, Curacao, Aruba, and St. Maarten. Initially, we believed we could secure sufficient mobile generators from our sister islands.

Electricity in Sint Maarten - voltage and frequency. All power sockets in Sint Maarten provide a standard voltage of 110V with a standard frequency of 60Hz. You can use all your equipment in Sint Maarten if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 100V-127V. This is mostly the case in the US, Canada and countries in South America.
