

What is France's energy sector?

France's energy sector is dominated by fossil fuels and nuclear energy; the latter of which France is the most strenuous supporter and largest producer in Europe.

France has a low-carbon electricity mix owing to its nuclear fleet, yet many reactors are reaching the end of their lifetime. The country has started an ambitious energy transition by designing a national low-carbon strategy, carbon budgets, a carbon

What are the sources of bio energy in France?

The main sources for bio energy generation in France are (i) solid biomass (wood energy and other solid components), (ii) renewable waste (household waste, paper waste, agricultural waste) and (iii) biogas (produced by the fermentation of biological materials).

How much will France Relance invest in the energy sector?

In addition, in October 2021, the authorities announced a new investment plan called "France 2030." The plan, worth EUR30 billion until 2027, would complement France Relance and especially target further investment in the energy sector (EUR8 billion).

What are France's energy goals?

France aims to boost the share of renewable energy to at least 33% of total energy consumption and 40% of electricity production by 2030 and these targets are set out by law. The government set out specific near-term targets under the 10-year energy investment plans (programmation pluriannuelle de l'énergie or PPE) enacted in 2020.

Will France achieve net zero emissions by 2050?

In 2019, France put its target to reach net zero emissions by 2050 into law and updated its energy transition framework the following year with a new National Low-Carbon Strategy and 10-year energy plan. However, France's energy transition has experienced significant delays, and implementation remains challenging despite the many reforms underway.
