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Geneva-based chipmaker STMicroelectronics has signed a long-term power purchase agreement (PPA) with a Malaysian joint venture of French power utility Engie SA to source about 50 GWh a year from a new solar farm in the Asian country, the parties said today.

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SINGAPORE: French energy firm Engie said on Tuesday it has started commercial operations at its Kerian solar power project in Malaysia, the company's first such plant in Southeast Asia. The project, located in Perak state, has a capacity of 100 megawatt (MW), or 136.44 megawatts-peak (MWp), Engie said in a statement.

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ENGIE Renewable SEA Pte Ltd, through BKH Solar Sdn Bhd that it established with Conextone Energy Sdn Bhd, has signed a 21-year power purchase agreement with STMicroelectronics for solar power from a new plant in Malaysia.
