

Is biomass a source of electricity in Equatorial Guinea?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. A mixture of global divestment from fossil fuels and local complications such as ownership requirements and an elevated political risk climate have deterred would-be investors. The Exxon situation is a case in point.

Is Equatorial Guinea a reversal of fortunes?

It almost marks a reversal of fortunes for Equatorial Guinea, which was once a hotbed of promise when Mobil discovered oil there and Exxon increased production after its takeover in 1999. But oil production has been steadily declining in recent years, down more than 80 per cent from the boom years.
