The Equatoguinean government believes that at least 2.3 tons of gold were collectively produced from these small operations. In 2006, the United States Geological Survey reported that about 200 kg of gold were produced in Equatorial Guinea.

Who is Equatorial Guinea's Current Minister?

The current minister is Don Antonio Oburu Ondo, appointed in 2023. The production of minerals such as gold and iron in Equatorial Guinea began in the pre-colonial period, although it did not reach commercial levels until after the Spanish era, while agriculture and forestry were the pillars of the colonial economy.
