

Where does South Africa's power come from?

However, the problem is that South Africa's power generation has come from Mpumalanga and Limpopo, which is where most of the grid networks are. Scheppers said: "The reality is that where we find the best renewable resources in the Northern, Eastern and Western Cape, the network is not adequately developed.

How much does wind power cost in South Africa?

The projects are Coleskop Wind Power in the Eastern Cape, coming in at R601.17 per megawatt hour, and San Kraal and Phezukomoya wind energy facilities in the Northern Cape, both coming in at R564.45 per megawatt-hour.

The government is focussing on diversifying the power mix by introducing natural gas and renewables, including concentrating solar power (CSP); South Africa has excellent natural resources for CSP development.
