According to estimates by the World Bank Group, Liberia has a solar potential of ~5.4 kWh/m 2 per day, with up to 6.5 h of sunshine per day on average. Similarly, Liberia has considerable hydroelectric power potential due to its numerous rivers and other resources.

Outdated infrastructure, fuel dependence, and funding constraints hinder progress. Abundant renewables, international support, and off-grid options offer solutions.

#### How can Liberia improve energy reliability?

As exemplified by Liberia's import initiatives, regional energy cooperationshould be considered to bolster energy reliability. Engineers are advised to optimize energy mixes, incorporating wind, biomass, and solar energy into existing grids, and developing mini-grid initiatives for rural areas to address energy access challenges.

#### Did Power Africa grant a solar energy project in Liberia?

Power Africa, through the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) awarded grants totaling \$669,330 to five solar energy companies operating in Liberia.

Imported electricity Liberia imports electricity from neighboring Côte d'Ivoire and Guinea through the West African Power Pool(WAPP) interconnection ,which involved 650 km of 225 kV transmission lines ,with a transit capacity of <=290 MW - making it the largest source of imported electricity for the country in 2020.
