

How does Fingrid procure mfrf capacity?

Fingrid procures mFRR capacity through the balancing capacity market, which is held when needed. Balance service provider pledges itself to leave regulating bids on the regulation market. For that the balance service provider is entitled to capacity payment. Day-ahead transmission capacity from Finland (FI) to North-Sweden (SE1).

How much transmission capacity does Fingrid have from Russia to Finland?

Fingrid has reserved 100 MW of transmission capacity from Russia to Finland to buy reserve power. The technical maximum capacity from Finland to Russia is 350 MW, of which Fingrid has reserved 30 MW to buy reserve power. The capacity given to intraday market means transfer capacity after day-ahead trade from Russia to Finland.

How many MW does Fingrid have?

Fingrid and the Russian parties, who have jointly agreed that the capacity is 140 MW in both directions, daily confirm the capacity. Cogeneration of district heating based on the real-time measurements in Fingrid's operation control system. The data is updated every 3 minutes.

How does Fingrid procure FFR?

Fingrid procures FFR based on the procurement prognosis. The prognosis is updated once a day, typically at 11:00 (EET). The Fast Frequency Reserve (FFR) is procured to handle low-inertia situations. The needed volume of Fast Frequency Reserve depends on the amount of inertia in the power system and the size of the reference incident.

How does Fingrid regulate power plants?

Fingrid orders up- or down-regulation from the Balancing energy market. Down-regulation considers increasing of consumption or reducing of generation. Reserve power plants electrical production is based on the real-time measurements in Fingrid's operation control system.

What is the location information for Fingrid's solar power forecast?

Location information is a very rough estimate based on Finnish distribution grid operators information. The data before 31.05.2023 is in hourly resolution. This is the total solar power production capacity used in Fingrid's solar power forecast. It is based on the small scale production statistics gathered by the Energy authority.

Since 2016 Fingrid has been procuring mFRR capacity (up-regulation) on a weekly market to maintain enough mFRR balancing bids to cover the dimensioning fault in Finland. Due to changes in the Finnish electricity production palette, the demand for mFRR capacity is rising and due to this, Fingrid is also developing the national mFRR capacity market.

Fingrid procures aFRR reserve from Nordic capacity market. aFRR is procured for hours during which the frequency tends to vary the most. The procurement hours are informed in advance. A balance service provider can submit bids to the capacity and energy markets separately for up-regulation and down-regulation.
