

What is solar energy in Poland?

Solar energy in Poland includes the production of solar thermal energy and solar photovoltaics. By the end of 2021, there were around 3,000,000 square metres (32,000,000 sq ft) of installed solar thermal collectors which in Poland are primarily used for heating up household water.

How has Poland developed its solar industry?

The government has introduced several measures to promote the development of the solar industry, including feed-in tariffs, net metering, and renewable energy auctions. Furthermore, renewable energy auctions have driven Poland's solar industry's growth.

What are the conditions for solar energy generation in Poland?

Poland has favorable conditions for solar energy generation, with a good amount of sunlight throughout the year. The government has introduced several measures to promote the development of the solar industry, including feed-in tariffs, net metering, and renewable energy auctions.

How important is PV energy in energy production in Poland?

The importance of energy from PV installations in energy production in Poland increased significantly. The share of PV energy in electric power from RES increased from 3% in 2019 to more than 23.3% in 2022 and 4.5% in the total generation structure (four years ago, it was only 0.4%).

How much solar energy will Poland produce in 2021?

In 2021, according to the IRE simulation, PV generation will amount to approximately 5,289 GWh (Fig. ). In 2020, 1.5% of the electricity produced in the country came from PV sources. In 2021, it will be 3.5%, while in 2025, solar energy will provide about 10% of Poland's electricity.

How many photovoltaics are there in Poland?

Recently, a rapid development of solar energy has been observed in Poland and is estimated that the country now has about 700,000 photovoltaics prosumers. In October 2021, the total photovoltaics power in Poland amounted to nearly 5.7 GW. The calculated technical potential of photovoltaics in Poland is 153.484 PJ (42.634 TWh).

As of the end of 2023, Poland had exceeded 17GW of cumulative installed solar PV capacity, as reported by the Institute for Renewable Energy (IEO), a Polish research group. At the close of December 2023, Poland's cumulative installed solar PV capacity had reached 17,057MW, the largest among all renewable sources.
