Saint Pierre and Miquelon has a domestic football league comprising three teams. Starting in 2018, local clubs have competed in France's domestic knockout cup, the Coupe de France. The department of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon is served by three television stations: Saint-Pierre-et-Miquelon 1 (call sign FQN) on Channel 8, with a repeater on Channel 31, and France 2 on Channel 6.

Does Saint-Pierre and Miquelon have a health care system?

Saint-Pierre and Miquelon's health care system is entirely public and free. In 1994, France and Canada signed an agreement allowing the residents of the archipelago to be treated in St. John's.

How did Saint-Pierre and Miquelon become a territory?

After the 1958 French constitutional referendum, the territory of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon was asked to choose one of three options: becoming fully integrated with France, becoming a self-governing state within the French Community, or preserving the status of an overseas territory; it decided to remain a territory.
