

Can solar energy replace fossil fuels on Pitcairn Island?

Pitcairn's authorities have launched a renewable energy project designed to replace fossil fuels with solar energy. The goal is to replace 95% of the current diesel consumption on Pitcairn Island (75,000 liters per year) with a combination of energy saving and solar electricity through the installation of a hybrid photovoltaic solar energy system.

Are the Pitcairn Islands Green?

Pitcairn Islands, a group of five islands with a total area of 47 km² and which constitute one of the most remote archipelagos in the world, turn to safer, greener energies that best meet the needs of the population. Pitcairn's authorities have launched a renewable energy project designed to replace fossil fuels with solar energy.

How many islands are in the Pitcairn Islands?

The Pitcairn Islands form the southeasternmost extension of the geological archipelago of the Tuamotus of French Polynesia, and consist of four islands: Pitcairn Island, Oeno Island (atoll with five islets, one of which is Sandy Island), Henderson Island and Ducie Island (atoll with four islets).

How to get to Pitcairn Islands?

Totegegie Airport in Mangareva can be reached by air from the French Polynesian capital Papeete. There is one 6.4-kilometre (4 mi) paved road leading up from Bounty Bay through Adamstown. The main modes of transport on Pitcairn Islands are by four-wheel drive quad bikes and on foot.

Two coal power stations in the east midlands - Cottam and West Burton A - are now to be home to solar PV with a combined capacity of over 1GW. The Channel Islands are set to welcome their first solar farm by the end of 2024, marking a significant milestone in the region's shift towards renewable energy. Jersey Electricity (JE) has confirmed that the solar farm, located on an 11-acre site in St Clement fields, will consist of nearly 7,500 solar panels and is expected to cost around £163.5m.
