The Sri Lanka Energy Balance published by the Sri Lanka Sustainable Energy Authority in 2019 outlines that the total energy requirement of the country was 509.6 Petajoule(PJ) in 2019, and the primary energy supply mainly consisted of 223.8 PJ of Petroleum, 169.0 PJ of biomass, and 58.7 PJ of coal.

In Sri Lanka, Grevillea and Albizia seedlings are planted at an initial spacing of 6 m × 6 m with medium shade trees interplanted midway between two high shade trees at the spacing of 3 m × 3.6 m. By the third year, high shade is finally thinned down to a spacing of 12 m × 12 m and medium shade to 6 m × 7.2 m (Tea Research Institute 2003).
