

## Store electricity at home St Vincent and Grenadines

What is the power supply in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines?

The power supply in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines is 110V, however some of the newer hotels operate at 230V. Electricity supplies worldwide can vary from anything between 100V and 240V. It can be extremely dangerous to use an electrical appliance that is rated at a voltage different from the supply.

Do I need a voltage converter in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines?

As voltage can differ from country to country, you may need to use a voltage converter or transformer whilst in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. If the frequency is different, the normal operation of an electrical appliance may also be affected. For example, a 50Hz clock may run faster on a 60Hz electricity supply.

What type of plugs are used in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines?

The power plugs and outlets used in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines are the types A, B, and G plugs. Type A plug has two flat parallel pins. The type B plug has two flat parallel pins and a round grounding pin. Type G plug has three rectangular pins arranged in a triangular pattern.

When was electricity introduced to St Vincent and the Grenadines?

Electricity was first introduced to St Vincent and the Grenadines in 1931 by the then Crown Colony Government. At that time, the service was provided to thirty-two customers in the capital city, Kingstown, during the night.

How is electricity used in St Vincent's Hospital?

Electricity is used in St Vincent's Hospital for space cooling, ventilation, lighting, medical equipment and many other processes. Natural gas and steam is used for space heating, sterilisation of medical equipment, cooking and domestic hot water.

In Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, two voltage levels are in use (110 / 230 V), which can vary by region, city, or sometimes even hotel. Your electric devices typically operate at 120 V in the United States. So please check the local voltage before using your devices! If the local voltage is much higher at 230 V, you need a voltage converter.
