The agreement accelerates the development of Ukraine's energy storage market and the development of more storage capacity. Energy storage systems are a strategic priority for DTEK Group. The company is building Poland's first large electricity storage project, as part of a goal to create a pan-European energy system that unites Ukraine and the EU.

State-owned NJSC NaftoGaz, subordinated to the cabinet of ministers, is the largest company in Ukraine. Until January 2020 it was a vertically integrated company engaged in the full cycle of gas and oil exploration operations: drilling, development and production; transport, refining and storage; and supplying natural gas and liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) to consumers.
