

Why did a UN Chief visit Timor-Leste?

The appeal was made at a time when several leaders were calling for immediate intervention by peacekeeping forces to protect the people of Timor-Leste from the violence that erupted after the referendum. The UN chief also visited a replica of a hideout used by Timorese resistance fighters.

What is happening in Timor-Leste?

The message was clear--without the right data, lives are at risk. Efforts are now underway in Timor-Leste to close this gap. As part of the UNEP initiative, nine Automatic Weather Stations, two Automated Meteorological Observation systems, three radars and a marine buoy are being installed across the country.

Is Timor-Leste a good country?

Speaking to journalists at the Government Palace in Dili, the UN chief highlighted Timor-Leste's record in strengthening democracy and human rights, as well as its "growing international influence".

How can Timor Leste tackle malnutrition?

Addressing malnutrition in Timor Leste,including stunting,which affects one out of every two children,starts with prevention. The crucial first 1000 days of a child,from conception to the second birthday define not only health and resilience,but also cognitive hardware.

The Secretary-General said he was counting on Timor-Leste to take a leading role in supporting a future peace process in Myanmar,which has spiralled into chaos since the military coup of 2021 ousted the democratically-elected government.
